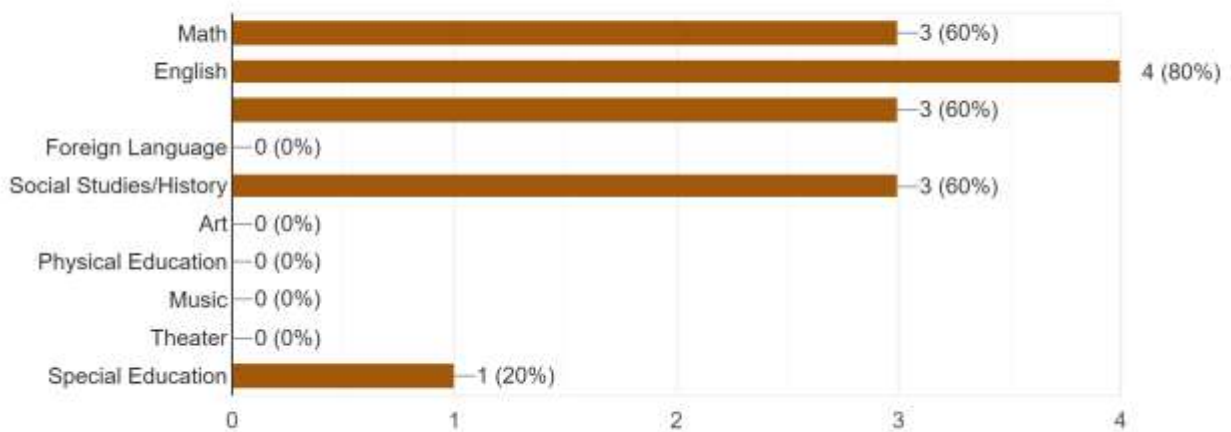
Demographic information of school
